What does it cost to use the Community Minibuses?

The charge to use the minibus is 90p per mile when your own driver is used or we can offer a with driver hire at £1 per mile (subject to volunteer availability).

All drivers must have undergone MIDAS training.

There is a minimum hire charge of £25.

Our Minibuses

We currently have three minibuses available for hire. They are:

A Citroen Relay 17 Seater including driver with the ability to take up to 2 wheelchairs and 8 seated passengers.

A Volkswagen 16 Seater including driver with the ability to take up to 2 wheelchairs and 12 seated passengers.

A Ford Transit 16 Seater including driver standard minibus.



Who Can Use the Minibus?

Any non-profit making community or voluntary group within East Lothian can book the minibus provided they are involved in one or more of the following activities: social welfare, education, sport, recreation or any other activity which is of benefit to the community.

The Minibus can be used for:

- Outings
- Monthly trips
- Shopping
- Sporting events
- Going to meetings
- Musical events
- Competitions
- Theatre trips
- Cinema
- Bowling

In fact, the list is endless!



Who Can Drive the Minibus?

Any driver who have passed their MiDAS training and are approved and registered with Lammermuir Community Transport.

Groups can nominate a volunteer to do their MiDAS training or we can provide a driver from our pool of volunteers.
(subject to availability)

For drivers joining the pool of volunteers who will drive for any Group, MiDAS training is free of charge.

For volunteers who only drive for their own specified group MiDAS training can be arranged at a cost.

What is MiDAS?

MiDAS (Minibus Driver Awareness Scheme) training is recognised throughout the UK as the standard training course for volunteer drivers involved in community transport.
